Dawn Doughty called the meeting to order at 4:06 pm.

Motion to approve minutes of the 4/6/2023 was made, approved and seconded.

### Treasurer's Report: Chris Tribelli

Chris Tribelli reviewed the financial reports, highlights are:

Bank interest received from the money market account for \$561 March and \$668 April Credit Card expired – credit card sent to Denise Lewis, Chris has requested a new card. Dawn made a motion to approve, Lisa seconded.

## **Presidents Report: Lisa Napolitano**

Albee Bridge Road Repair Project - Issues discussed – post card sent to all residents project to end May 20... some closures can be expected.

## **Security: Dawn Doughty**

Dawn reported that the monthly incident report from the Sheriff's Office has not been received. Dawn usually get this report at the end of the first week of each month.

Dawn Doughty updated the board on Flock Cameras. Two cameras installed in the motel district at 129 and 213 Casey Key Road. West side of the road / in bound out bound. Two additional cameras were installed at the Casey Key Fish House without the required solar panels, cameras are non-functioning at this time. Flock Safety will come back on May 11 to install solar panels. As soon as solar panels are installed, Dawn will sign-up for training for the software. Cost to be \$10,600 year 1 and \$9,600 year 2.

Dawn reported that Sheriff has increased their rates for our patrol from \$45 to \$58 per hour. Dawn waived for the use of a marked vehicle at a savings of \$10/hour to help offset the increased rates. This will maintain patrols at their current level, but we will not have the visibility of marked vehicles. We currently have budgeted \$45K for security patrols.

Donna Lebaron gave a brief recap of the events with the Sheriff's Office since the theft at

their home on August 22, 2022. A safe was stolen from their beach house containing 7 figure amounts in valuables. The case was not solved by the Sheriff's Office. In November, the Lebaron's hired a private detective, Tom Simon PD. Tom discovered melted gold coins were pawned at pawn shop, reported to Sheriff's Office with no reply or apparent follow-up from Sheriff. Lebaron requested a meeting with Sheriff. Meeting was attended by attorney. The PA shared his information with Sheriff.

Within 15 days Tom solve the crime without any assist from the Sheriff. Received part of the belonging back. Request to keep pressure on the Sheriff and added security. The Lebaron's have spoken with Commissioners Mark Smith and Joe Neunder about the incident and their frustration with the handling by the Sheriff's Office.
